

Requirements

- # B1, B4, D3, F3, E3, C3, A1, A4 (Background)
- # D2, F2, E2,C2 (Fabric 1)
- # B2, D1, F1, E1, C1, A2 (Fabric 2)
- # B3, F4, E4, A3 (Fabric 3)
- # D4, C4 (Fabric 4)


Cutting

Suggested piece sizes


- **>** B4, A4 2 ¼" x 4 ¼"
- ➤ B3, A3 2" x 3"
- ➤ B2, A2 1 ½" x 2 ¼"
- ➤ B1, A1 3" x 3"
- ➤ D4, C4 2" x 3"
- ➤ D2, C2 2 1/4" x 3 1/2"
- >< D1, C1 2 ½" x 4"
- **>** D3, C3 2 ¼" x 4"
- ➤ F3, E3 3 1/4" x 1 1/2"
- **>** F2, E2 1 ¾" x 4"
- >< F1, E1 1 ¾" x 4"
- F4, E4 2 ¼" x 4 ¼"

Block Assembly


- Paper piece individual sections and trim leaving ¼" seam allowance around each section.
- 2. Sew sections B, D and F together to make a half.
- 3. Press F seam towards section D and D seam towards section B.
- 4. Sew sections A, C, E together to make a half.
- 5. Press seam E seam towards section C and C seam towards section A.
- 6. Sew both halves together. Press seam open.
- 7. Remove papers.
- 8. Unfinished block measures 6 ½" x 6 ½".
