

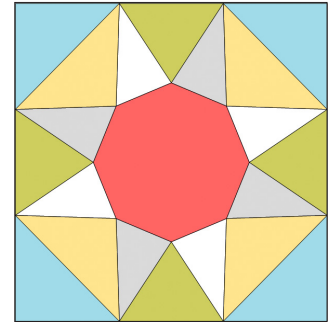

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"

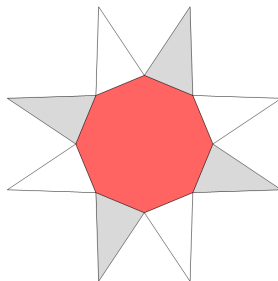


Cut and prepare EPP

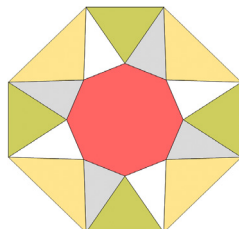
- ✂ 1 Octagon, shape 1
- ✂ Each 4 pointy triangles, shape 2 (note one triangle is just the mirrored shape of the other)
- ✂ 4 triangles (shape 3)
- ✂ 4 triangle (shape 4)
- ✂ 4 triangle (shape 5)

Block Assembly

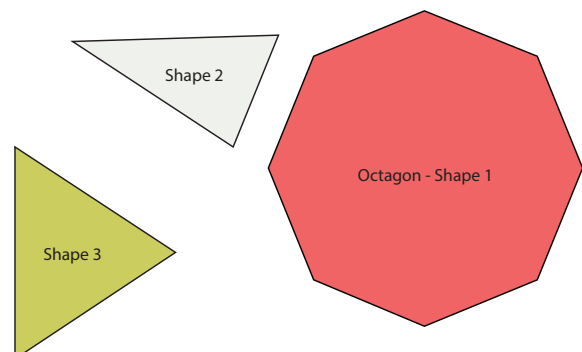
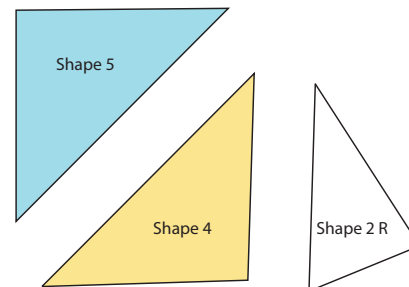
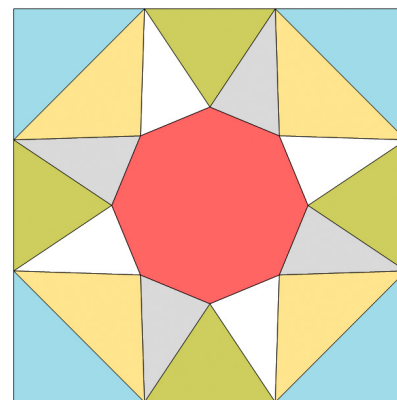
1. Start by sewing the pointy triangles shape 2 around the octagon. Make sure to alternate the regular and the mirrored shapes.

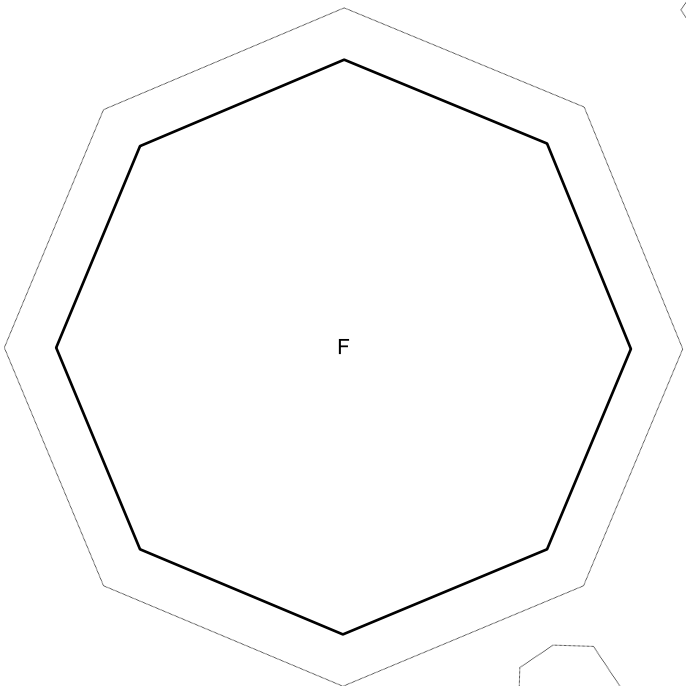
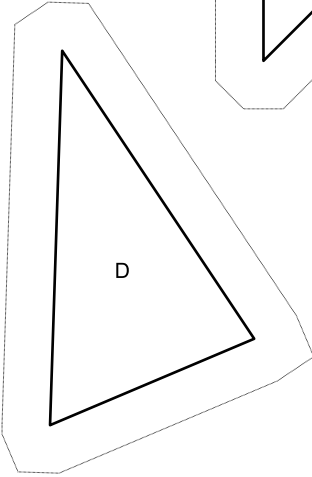
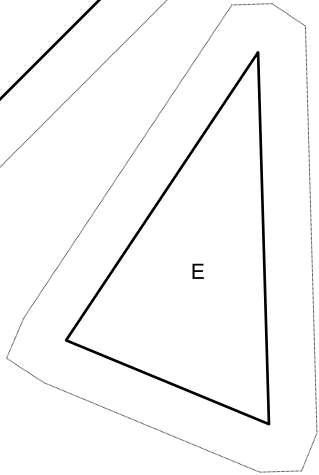
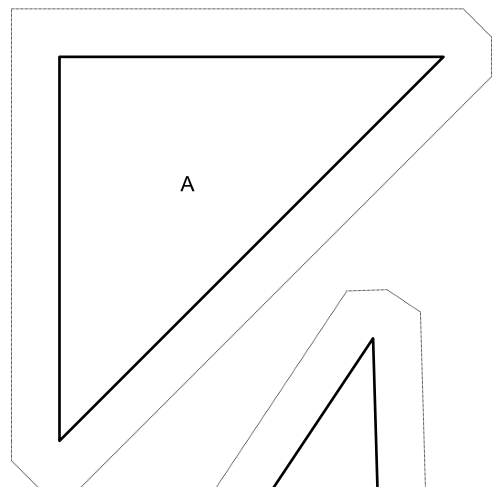
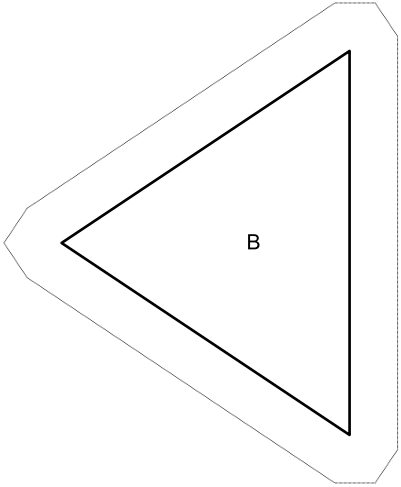
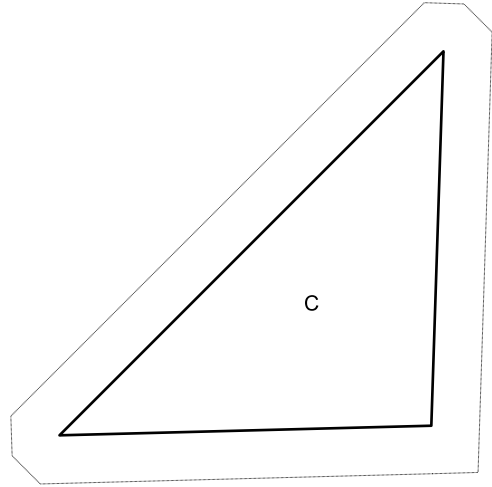
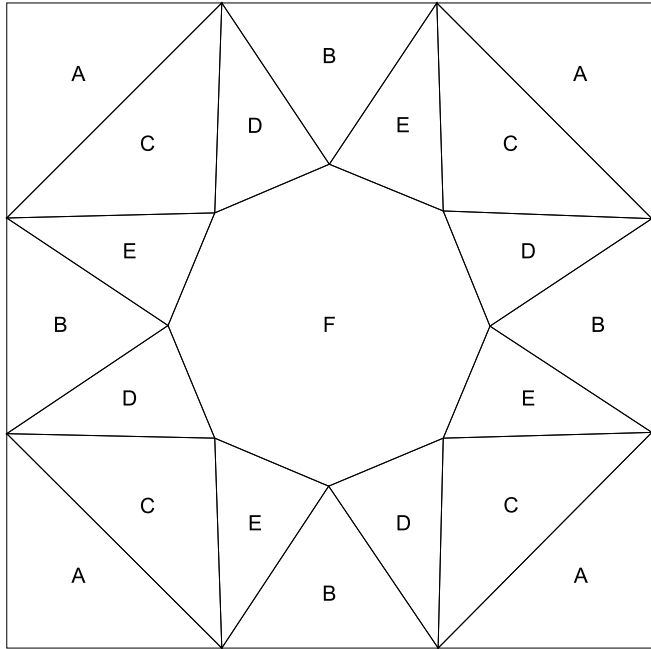


2. Insert triangles shapes 3 in the tighter triangles spaces, and shapes 4 in the wider spaces between the star points.



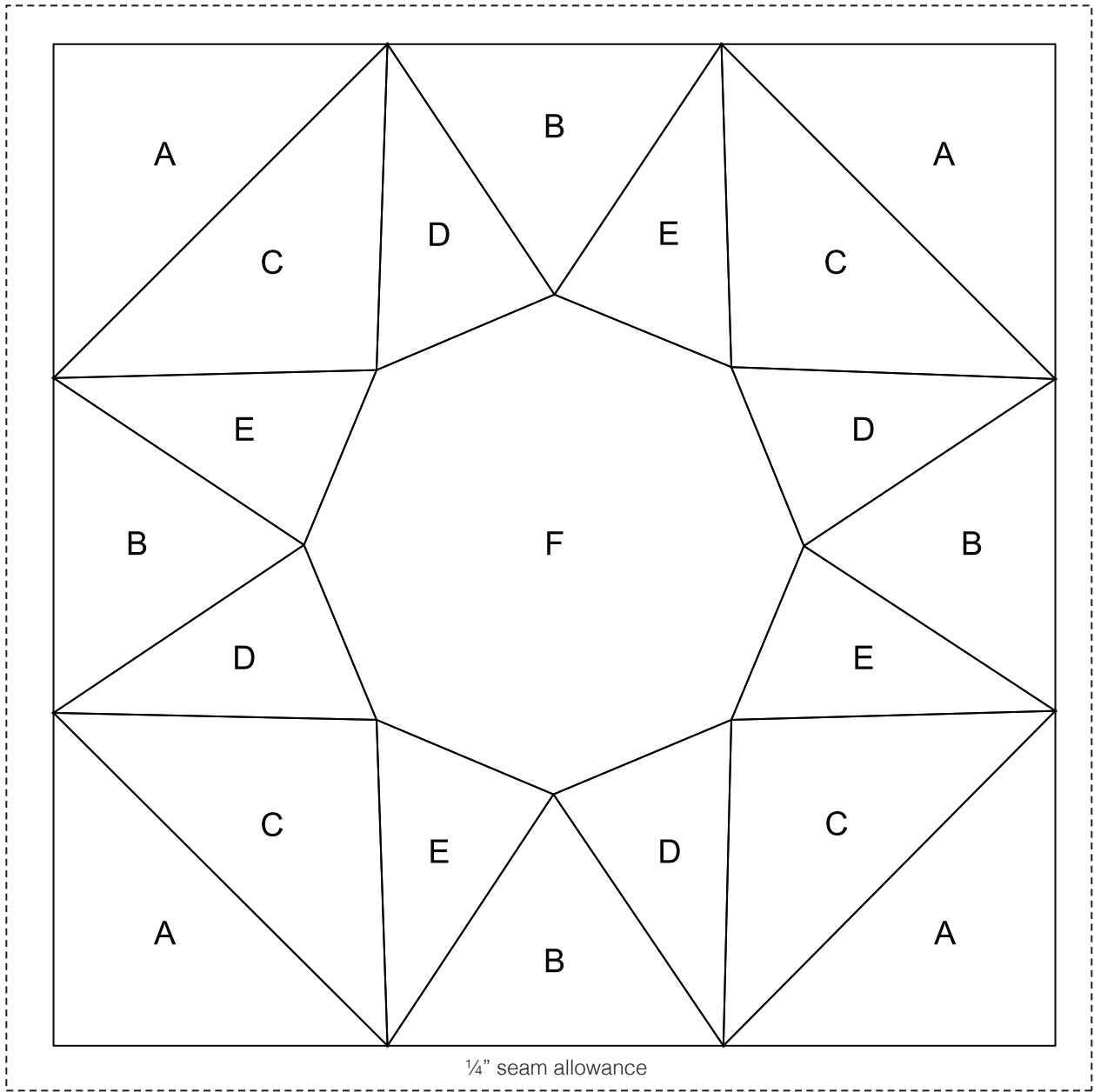
3. Add triangle shapes 5 to the four corners.
