

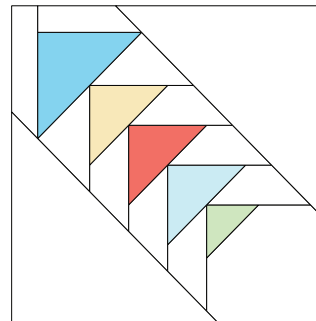

Homeward Bound

for the Splendid Sampler™

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"



Requirements

- ✚ 5 different prints
- ✚ 18" x 18" strip of background fabric

Cutting

Flying geese

Choose 5 prints and cut the following strips and cut:

- ⊃ A2 - 1 ½" x 2"
- ⊃ A5 - 2" x 3"
- ⊃ A8 - 2" x 3"
- ⊃ A11 - 2" x 3"
- ⊃ A14 - 2 ½" x 3 ½"

Background

Cut the following strips from your background fabric:

- ⊃ A1 - 3" square
- ⊃ A3 & A4 - (cut 2) 1 ½" x 3"
- ⊃ A6, A7, A9, A10, A15 - (cut 5) 1 ½" x 3 ½"
- ⊃ A12 & A13 - (cut 2) 2" x 3 ½"
- ⊃ A16 - (cut 1) 1 ½" x 4 ½"
- ⊃ A17 & A18 - (cut 1) 5 ½" square, cut in half on the diagonal

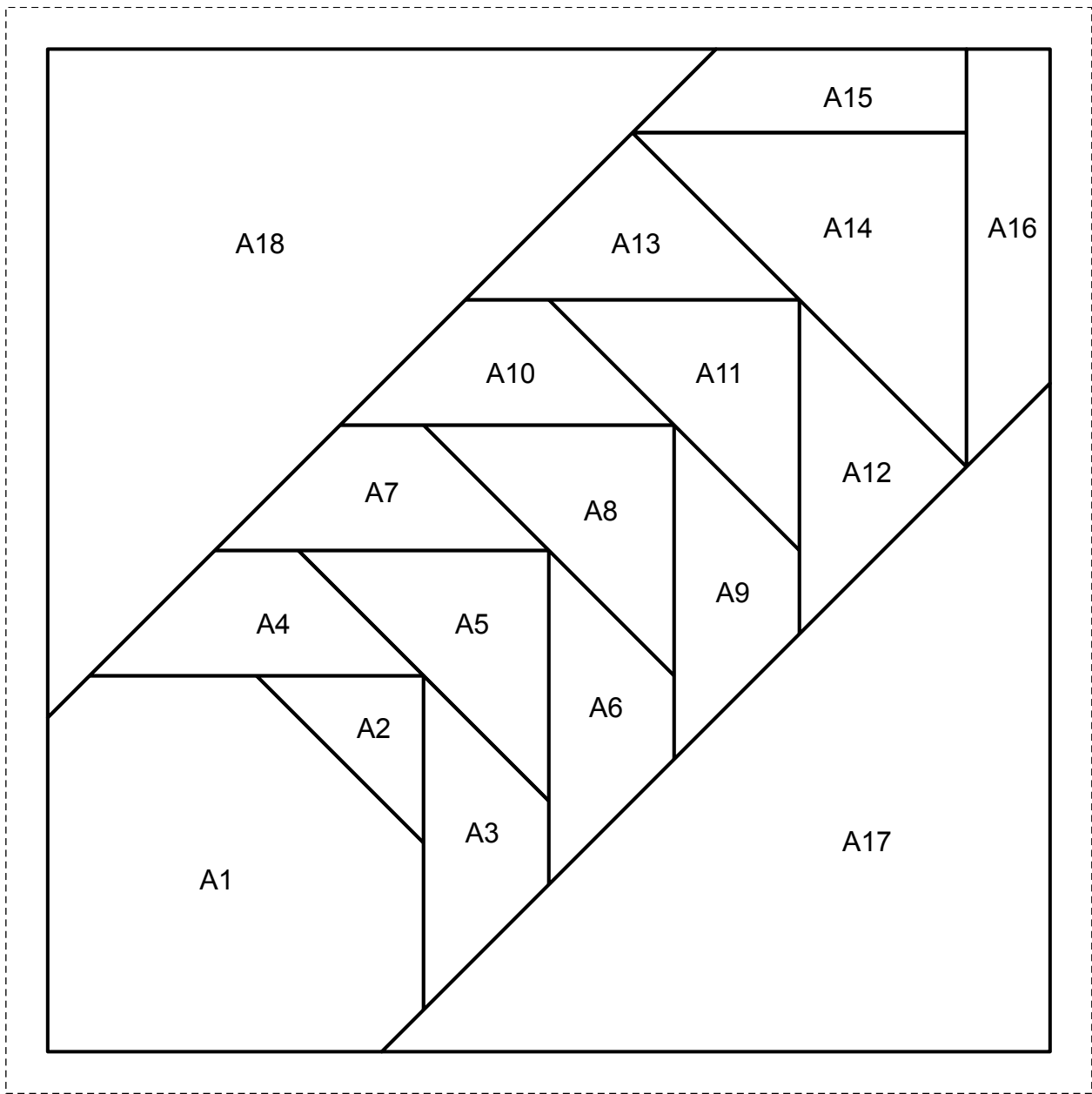
Block Assembly

1. Print out one template and measure to make sure it measures 6 ½" x 6 ½" square (a ¼" seam allowance is included in the template).
2. Using the paper template add pieces in numerical order, using the foundation paper piecing technique.
3. Trim on the dotted line and then carefully remove paper from the back of the block.
4. The block should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished.



Paper Piecing Template

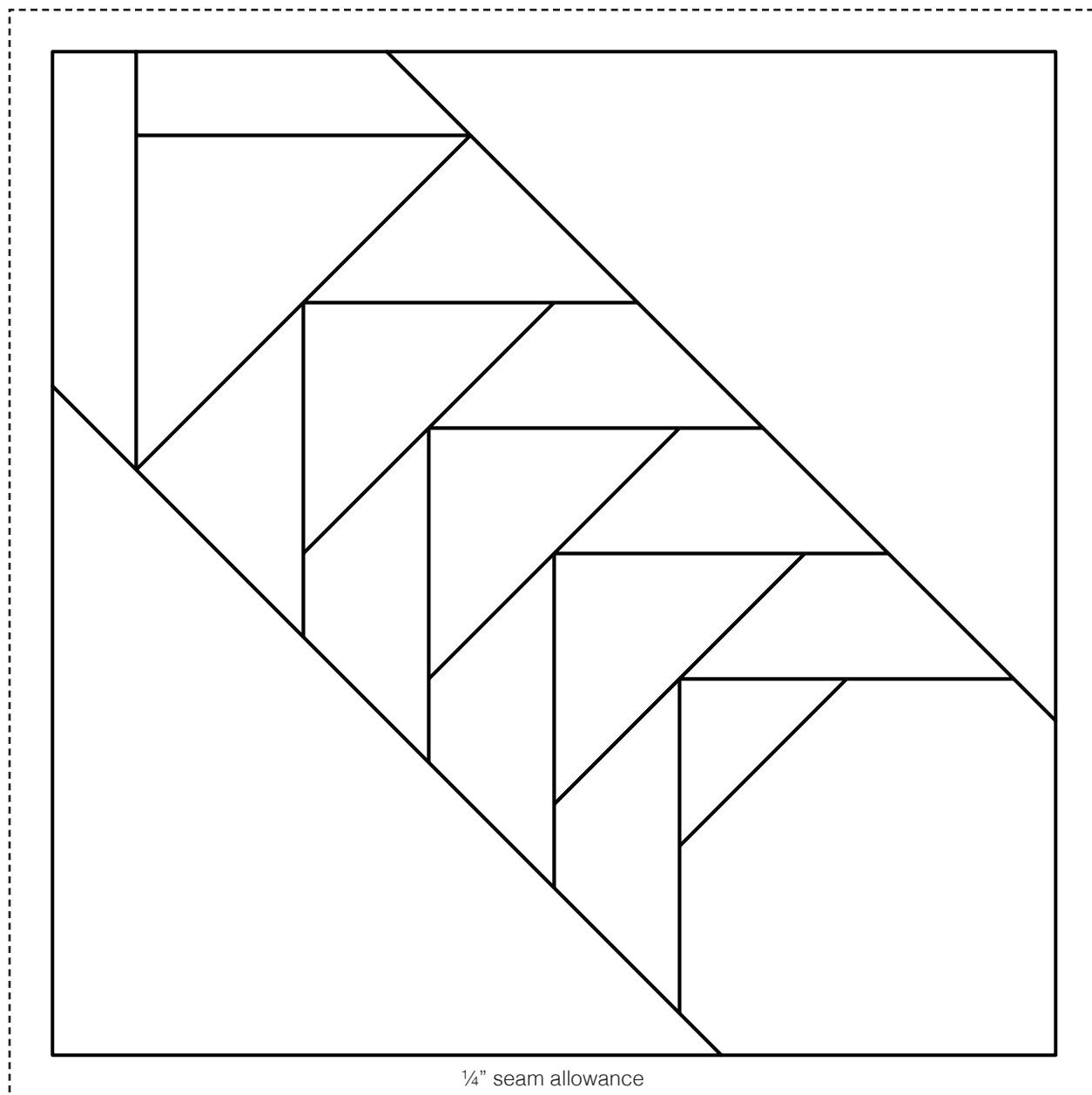
Template is in reverse
